The first Brewster in Bloom Festival was founded in 1986 after a group of Brewster business people planted daffodils all over town that would greet everyone with bright blooms following a gloomy Cape Cod winter! During the first years, proceeds were used to fund the construction of the band gazebo at Drummer Boy Park.

Today, proceeds benefit the Brewster in Bloom Grant and Scholarship Program, providing \$3,200 in scholarships to Brewster students pursuing higher education. The program is managed by the Brewster Chamber of Commerce, Inc.
